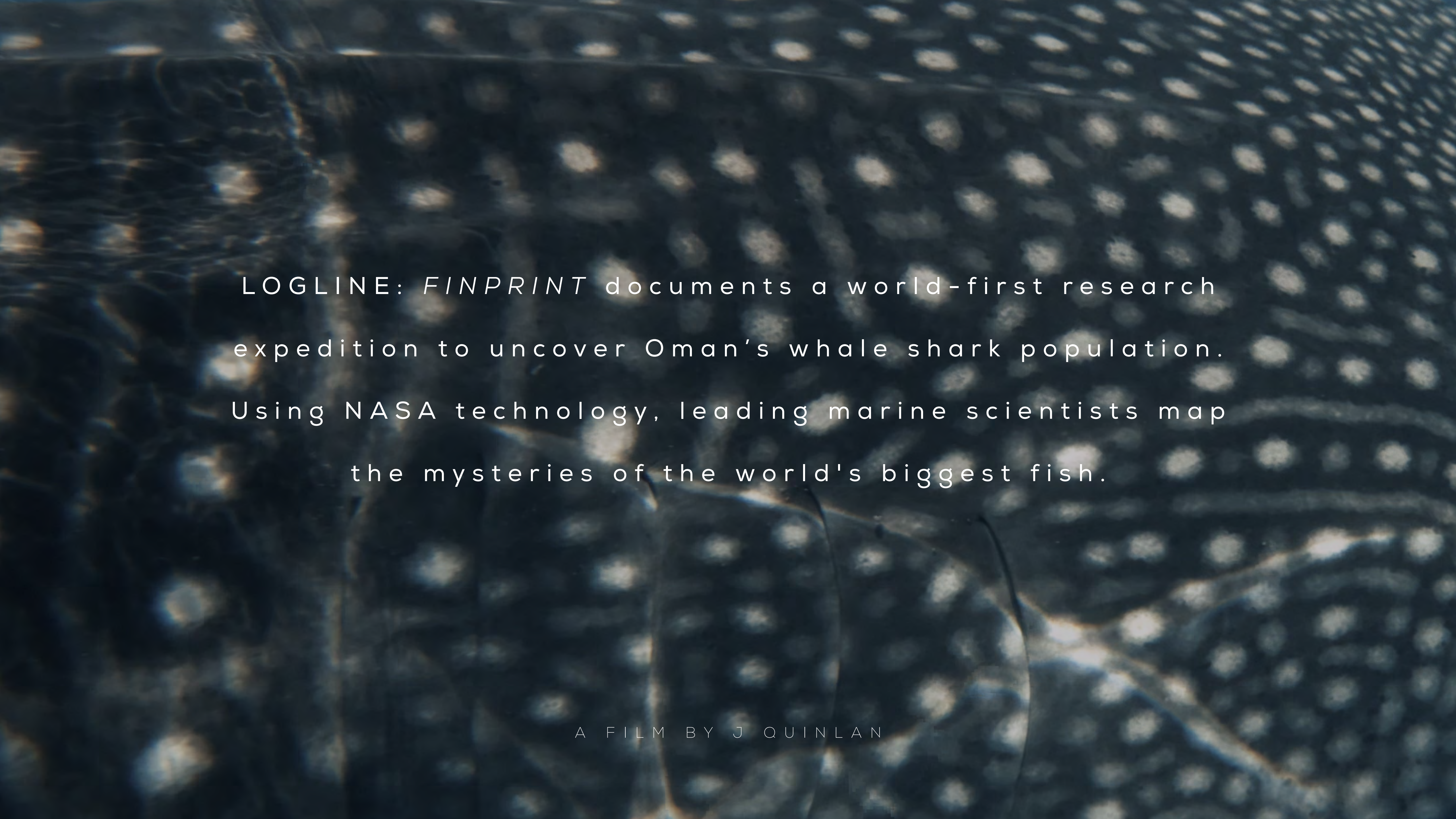

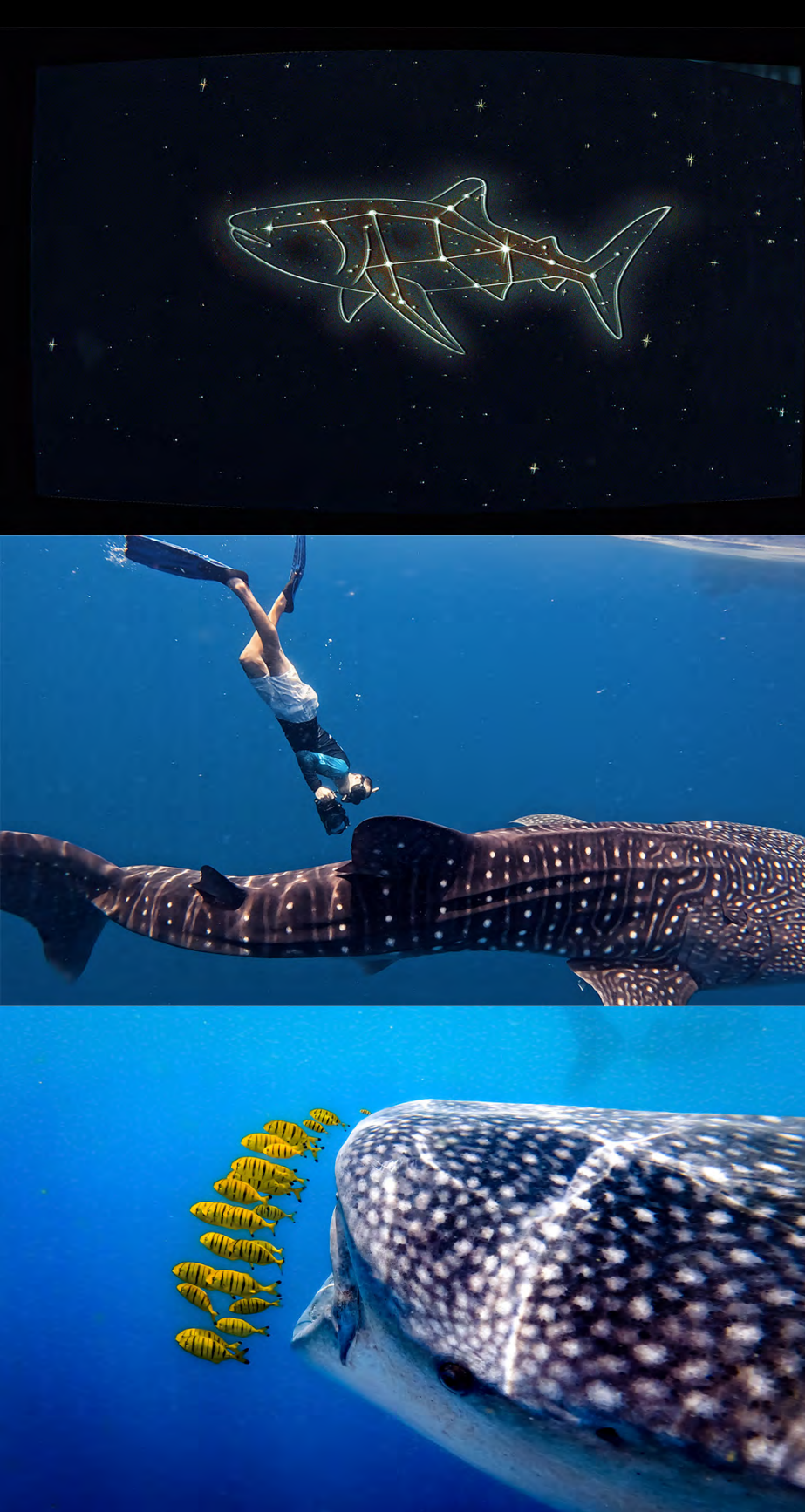

LOGLINE: *FINPRINT* documents a world-first research expedition to uncover Oman's whale shark population. Using NASA technology, leading marine scientists map the mysteries of the world's biggest fish.

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SYNOPSIS

They are the biggest fish in the sea, yet remain one of its biggest mysteries. As global whale shark populations rapidly decline, the Gulf of Oman remains one of the final unexplored frontiers for researching the species.

FINPRINT documents a world-first expedition to study an Arabian whale shark population that has been lost to science for decades - until now. Using NASA technology, leading marine scientists map the mysteries of these giant sharks in Oman.

But for a fish so large, it's baffling how the adults, females and neonates seem to all but vanish from records. What's more, they can dive so deep that it's hypothesised they are using the Earth's magnetism to navigate the planet - a stark reminder that we know more about outer space than we do our own oceans.

The research team use satellite tags, photo-IDs and tissue samples to map these elusive fish. We follow every breath-hold to collect the critical data required to secure legally protected status for whale sharks in Oman and beyond.

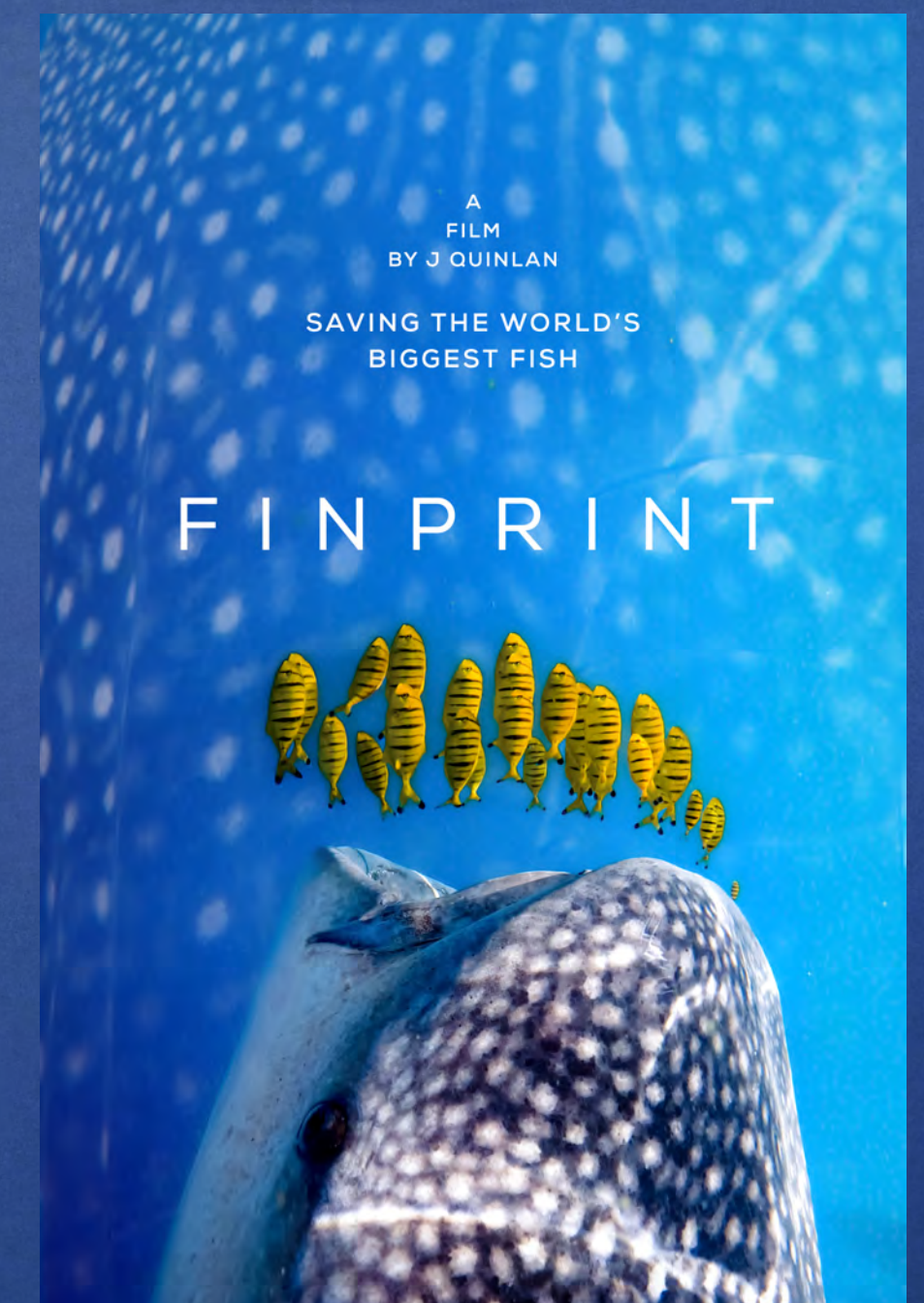
